Re: Storm Event Fay

Dear Baytree Residents:

Please be advised that the CDD is aware of the drainage issues within Baytree and are doing everything in our power to make sure that the CDD's stormwater system is functioning. District staff was onsite on Monday (8/18/08) to clean the roadside storm inlets prior to the storm. Following the storm, we have had our staff onsite to review the status of the District. All inlets and outlets appear to be clear. Staff is continuing to review the District to ensure that our stormwater system is functioning as intended. Please understand that the amount of rain that has fallen in the Baytree area exceeds the design parameters for this type of stormwater system.

We contacted the Brevard County Emergency Operations Center and spoke with the County Road and Bridge representatives and requested that they check their system downstream of ours to make sure that there are no blockages.

Updates:

- 8/22/08 – CDD Staff is on-site coordinating with vendors to pump water and review outfall structures. Our landscaper is removing debris currently. And street sweepers will be onsite on Wednesday (8/27) to assist with debris clean-up.
- 8/27/08 – Street Sweeping was completed today. The water has receded and the District staff continue to review the site to ensure that the stormwater system is functioning as intended
